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The Quaker Foundation invites the graduating classes of New Philadelphia High School to be a part of an exciting concept as we ask our alumni, individually and collectively, to accept The Class Challenge.

THE CLASS CHALLENGE

The Class Challenge invites each alumni class to raise funds through various projects or donations from classmates to total their class year in dollars. For example, the Class of 1954 was challenged to raise \$1,954.00. Several classes have included the challenge concept in their reunion mailings, and have asked individual class members to send one cent for each digit in their class year...which translates to \$19.54 in the above example. Although some classes have met The Class Challenge, we still need continued support for student scholarships, classroom grants and *Quaker Pride*. All contributions made by individual class members and class groups must state that the contribution is for The Class Challenge and the year of graduation in order to be counted toward the Challenge. Contributions may be mailed to the Quaker Foundation at P.O. Box 627, New Philadelphia, Oh 44663, with checks made out to the Quaker Foundation.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Contributions received by the Quaker Foundation are used to support the goals of the organization, including student scholarships. Last year we awarded over \$87,000 in scholarships. To date the Foundation has awarded over \$667,000 in scholarships.

CLASSROOM GRANTS

This year the Quaker Foundation awarded 34 grants totaling over \$15,000. 459 grants totaling \$181,102 have been awarded by the Foundation to date. This program benefits hundreds of students each year in grades K-12.

QUAKER PRIDE

The *Quaker Pride* newsletter is mailed out in July of every year to each alumnus and costs the Quaker Foundation \$.75 per copy. In 2009 nearly 14,000 newsletters were mailed.
